Deciding whether to incorporate federally or in Ontario? Ask yourself these questions:



Do you plan to operate nationwide/internationally?



Do you have national customers, suppliers, or international partners?



Will you have a registered Q office located in Ontario?



Are at least 25% of directors Canadian residents? (If there are only two directors, is one a Canadian resident?)





## IF YES

Federal incorporation is a wise choice for those businesses that need nationwide business name protection or wish to operate internationally.

## IF YES

Ontario incorporation may be enough if you plan to operate locally - within Ontario only.

You can apply for extra-provincial incorporation if you wish to expand operations to another province or territory.

And you can always federally incorporate after the fact, although you may not be able to keep the same name for your federally incorporated company.
